Part 1 – Wonder by R. J. Palacio

Lesson 1: Craft Your Hero

Lesson 2: Walk in their Shoes

Inspired by Auggie's first day at school, immerse yourself in the art of empathy. Craft personal narratives that capture the emotions, challenges, and lessons of navigating new beginnings.

Lesson 3: Perspectives Unveiled

Experience the unique style of "Wonder" by delving into the power of writing from different viewpoints. Through dynamic activities, learn to capture diverse perspectives and infuse depth into your narratives.

Lesson 4: Unravelling Julian's World

Investigate the motivations behind Julian's actions, the intriguing antagonist from "Wonder." Craft a section from Julian's perspective, offering a background that humanises the character and explores the complexities of storytelling.

Lesson 5: Inspire Through Words

Conclude your creative odyssey by crafting an inspiring acceptance speech for Auggie's award. Reflect on the lessons learned, the growth experienced, and the profound impact one individual can make. Learn the techniques of delivering powerful and resonant speeches that leave a lasting impression.

Lesson 6: The Power of Kindness

Dive into the transformative theme of kindness, central to "Wonder." Explore how small acts of kindness can create ripples of change in stories and real life. Through engaging exercises, craft a scene that highlights the impact of kindness—whether through dialogue, actions, or quiet moments. Learn to weave this universal theme into your writing, creating stories that inspire empathy, connection, and hope.





Part 2 – Wings Of Fire by Tui T. Sutherland

Lesson 1: Create Your Dragon Tribe

Invent your dragon tribe and delve into the magical world of world-building.

Lesson 2: Create your tribe's territory

Every tribe needs a territory. Using their creativity, students will learn how to create a vivid description of life in their territory, describing its environment, features and history.

Lesson 3: Creating lead characters

Craft a dragon protagonist with a compelling backstory and distinct personality, drawing inspiration from the dragonets of destiny.

Lesson 4: Building a plot.

Having done the hard work, students will now be challenged to come up with their own plots. They will be encouraged to create conflicts with tribes created by other course members to add an interactive element.

Lesson 5: Crafting an enticing opener

Students will now look at the best way to start their story. We will look at techniques and different styles before students will choose the version they feel most appropriate.

Lesson 6: How to write a gripping ending

Students will look to continue to work on their endings as we look at a variety of techniques and styles to end a story as they decide which type of ending will be the most appropriate for their own.
